

# How to Make Clip-It Clothespins

Hey kids! Make bright bag clips, colorful memo holders or creative magnets with clothespins! It's a snap!

## HERE'S WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Non-toxic washable paint & brushes
- Recycled newspaper
- Paper towels
- Container of water
- ♣ Clip clothespins
- Magnetic tape (optional)



# **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### STEP 1

Get ready to paint! Cover your craft area with old newspaper. Use non-toxic washable paint and a paintbrush to paint one side of your clothespins. Air-dry the paint. Then paint the other side (unless you're making a magnet). Air-dry the paint again.

#### STEP 2

Decorate! Use your imagination to decorate the clothespins. Paint on colorful bugs, geometric shapes, flowers, hearts, stripes, stars or other designs. Air-dry the designs.

#### STEP 3

Magnetize! If you wish, attach a small piece of magnetic tape. Press the sticky side against the clothespin.



## **SAFETY GUIDELINES**

1. Safety guidelines recommend this art project as suitable for children of all ages, including those 3 years and younger. Close adult supervision is required to ensure children's safety.
